





In 1923, according to statistical data, the population of Florești was 4455 people, in the city there were 3 mills, 3 oil factories, and an agricultural cooperative. In 1946, the town gained the status of a city. The city of Florești is located on the Rîbnița-Bălți railway tronson, being crossed by the Soroca-Bălți national road, factors that contributed to the development of the city's economic potential.
