



Information on the economical historical background, lost or almost lost industries but with potential to be rehabilitated, past specializations etc.

The appearance of Ocnița is related to the construction, at the end of the 19th century, of the Bălți-Cernăuți railway. Due to its advantageous location, at the point of intersection of two branches of the railways, in 1910 Ocnita became the local administrative center of the railways. At that time, the main warehouse and the locomotive repair shops were active here, slowly appeared an agricultural cooperative, a slaughterhouse, a primary and secondary school, a town hall, a post office, a telegraph, a telephone, a pharmacy, 6 pubs, etc. In 1946, Ocnița obtained the status of an urban type locality. În 1955, in Ocnița a brick production factory was built, with a capacity of 3 million bricks and 250 thousand tiles annually. Since 2003, the city of Ocnița is the administrative center of Ocnița district. Due to fertile soils agriculture occupied a central role in the economy of the district






